Christopher Efird, President of Access America Fund, LP, invited to speak at the International PIPE's Conference in Shanghai.

HOUSTON, May 14, 2010. Christopher Efird, the President of the Access America Fund, LP is invited to speak at the International PIPE's Conference in Shanghai, China on May 25, 2010. Mr. Efird will be joining a panel of industry thought leaders including David Feldman of Feldman LLP, Thomas Poletti of K&L Gates and Richard Rappaport of Westpark Capital to discuss the components of the "reverse merger" transaction. The panel will specifically focus on the issues and complexities of taking a Chinese Company public in the US.

The International PIPE's Conference organized by Deal Flow Media is the most highly regarded conference for the reverse merger industry and the largest gathering of institutionally funded Chinese companies interested in Reverse Mergers, foreign fund raising and alternative finance transactions in the United States.

Mr. Efird has been active in growth stage investing since 1988, in emerging market investing since 1995, and is one of the original innovators of the public US listing of companies based in emerging markets through alternative means. Over the course of his career, Mr. Efird has led or co-led the US public listing of sixteen growth stage companies, of which thirteen were based in the emerging markets. These sixteen companies represent the creation of over \$4 billion in new market capitalization as well as very significant wealth creation for their owners and increased economic potential for their native countries. In 1996, Mr. Efird led one of the first APO (Alternative Public Offering) transactions ever completed for an emerging market based company when he APO'd Mexico City based Telscape International which went on to grow by over 200X (to \$400 MM) in value and became one of the leading Latin American value added telecom companies of the late 1990's.
